

Privacy Policy

Here at Bear Property Inspections we love all things data and therefore we know how important it is to protect any information we receive from you, our customers and website visitors, and we want to keep you informed as to exactly what data we collect from you. We appreciate you visiting our website, www.bearpropertyinspections.com. We've created a privacy policy so that you know what to expect whenever you interact with our website. This Privacy Policy will be updated from time to time and we will notify you of any changes by updating our policy on this site. By using our website and services, you agree to the use, disclosure and procedures outlined in this Privacy Policy. Please be aware that this Privacy Policy does not apply to third party websites (a.k.a. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT FROM YOU

Our main goals when we collect information are to help fulfill the services you have requested from us, improve our website, services, content and overall experience of users accessing our site. We collect two types of information from you: Personally Identifiable Information ('Personal Information') and non-personally identifiable information ('Non-Personal Information'). We do not consider personal information to include information that has been anonymized or aggregated so that it can no longer be used to identify a specific person. This policy will cover both types and tell you how we may collect and use each.

Personal Information That We May Collect From You

- Your name and email address
- Your website comments and email correspondences with our company
- Other personal information necessary to fulfill services you have requested

Non-Personal Information We May Collect From You

- The IP address of the computer you used to access our services

- The type of browser and computer/phone software you are using
- The website address that linked you to our site (if applicable)
- The date and time you accessed our services
- Search engine search terms and advertising clicks/actions

Cookies and Pixel Tags

Like most websites, we use 'cookies' to collect information. Cookies are small files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit or certain emails you open. They are widely used in order to make websites function properly, as well as to provide business and marketing information to the owners of the site.

Examples of when we use cookies:

- When you login to our website that you have an account on
- When you fill out a form and have it autofill your information
- When you visit our site and later on see an ad for our products or services on Facebook, LinkedIn, etc.

If you do not want us to collect cookies, you can instruct your browser to stop accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from a website you visit. If you do not accept cookies, however, you may not be able to use all sessions and services on our website. Why Do We Retain Your Personal Information?

We retain Personal Information to fulfill our business purposes and our legal/regulatory obligations.

How We Use Your Personal Information

How long do we keep your personal information?

Ways that you can access, control and correct your personal information

- We will provide you with a copy of your personal information in a readable format upon request
- If your personal information is incorrect or incomplete, you have the right to ask us to update that information
- You have the right to object to our processing of your personal information
- You have the right to deny our ability to market directly to you
- You can also ask us to delete or restrict how we use your personal information, but this right is determined by applicable law and may impact your access to some of our services.

How to contact us to access, correct and delete your personal information

If you have a request that pertains to the personal information we maintain about you, we ask for the following:

- Your name, email address and postal address.
- Details of your request.

You must also provide:

- A photocopy of your driver's license or passport so we can confirm your identity
- Your signature and the date of the request.
- If you are applying on behalf of another person then signed authority from the individual is required.
